
Using a PowerMic III with Dragon Professional 15



Although Dragon 15 Professional if fully compatible with the PowerMic III, including the ability to easily program 10 of the PowerMic III buttons, full integration requires more than simply plugging in and using the PowerMic as a sound source.


- 1. Plug in the PowerMic and give your operating system a minute to install any needed drivers
- 2. Open Dragon Professional 15
- 3. Navigate to Settings > Microphone > Choose Microphone



4. From the window that opens, select the PowerMic and click "Finish"



5. To confirm that the PowerMic is functional, go to Settings > Options > and confirm that there is a tab related to the PowerMic. Assuming that it is there, select it and you will have access to all you need to program the PowerMic buttons.



Additional Notes:

- 1. Versions of Dragon Professional prior to 15 are NOT compatible with the PowerMic.
- 2. If you have a version of Dragon earlier than 15, another option to allow use with your PowerMic is a third-party utility called Octopus USB Controller (OUC).
